CLIFF TOP EXPERIENCE - GUIDED TOUR OF THE GIANTS CAUSEWAY in association with The National Trust Departs 12.15pm daily from the Giant's Causeway Visitor Centre

Experience the spectacular coastline of the Causeway Coast and connect with nature on a five-mile walk through Northern Ireland's only World Heritage Site.
